Possible Activities

1. Take photos of various things in different places around the school before the lesson. Show the children these photos and ask where the items can be found.

2. Ask questions about various things found in school. Children actually go to where the things are and find out the answers. The teacher can ask questions as follows.

How many steps are there in the stairway from the first floor to the second floor?

What color is the door of the school office?
